DELIVERING A GREAT LOCAL SCHOOL FOR GLENROY

Glenroy families will get the world-class local school their kids deserve, with a re-elected Andrews Labor Government to deliver a massive upgrade to Glenroy Secondary College.

Labor will invest \$9.2 million to transform tired old classrooms and facilities with a major upgrade to Block A, Block F and Block G. These buildings currently house facilities for administration, art and craft, home economic, and general purpose classrooms.

Every child should have a good local school and the chance to succeed in life, and only a re-elected Andrews Labor Government will deliver that for kids in Glenroy.

The Liberals slashed \$1 billion out of our education system, leaving schools to crumble and decay across the state.
